### My Very First EQuiP Experience

Hi everybody,

First, I would like to thank the School of Public Health "Andrija Štampar" in Zagreb, and especially Zlata Ožvačić Adžić and Dijana Ramić Severinac, EQuiP delegates in Croatia.

I am a Croatian GP, and I participated in the EQuiP meeting in Zagreb as a beginner and outsider. Thus, it was my very first EQuiP experience. I joined the meeting to get a glimpse of what it is all about, and maybe to find topics, which could be useful for my organisation Ko-HOM (Croatian Family Medicine Association) and VdGM (the new and future European GP's).

Sometimes when you approach a new organisation for the first time without knowing much about it, you are unconsciously biased with thoughts and prejudices like "there is not that much for me here", "they are probably all geeks and too specific". Well, for you EQuiP novices out there like me – if that's the case at least – I cannot help you. Because I found out that everything this WONCA Europe network does is very useful and of high quality.

Even if you are not interested in all the scientific work, you find your-self asking questions like: Why didn't I go through their web page earlier? There are lot of materials, which can help me and us to manage our daily practice, ready to be used and free to share. For example, there are videos on how to motivate patients with chronic conditions, manuals on how to use social media, how to deal with quality issues and make our practice better.
